1. House and Landowners Flood Measures

a) Leaky dams

- i. Auchermuchty and Strathmiglo Resilience Groups have installed two leaky dams. (Scottish Flood Forum Newsletter).
- ii. Moor Rd leaky dam visit unable to proceed at this time.

b) Two potential sites for leaky dams, that did not involve cultivated land, have been identified. These would need to be verified by an expert in the field of natural flood measures.

c) Online Meeting with Dom McBennett (Scottish Water) – Resilience Development in Dundee.

- identified 2 potential sites for a retention pond

- three local universities to be approached re a student/s, impact survey of leaky dams on the Windygates Burn

2. Supporting Ecosystem diversity:

Other dates for Infill hedge planting along the Brunton to Luthrie road (approx 250 yds) are awaited e.g. Autumn 2026 / early 2027.

3. Review of current measures in response to recent rainfall

i. Gritting the road in freezing weather – 2 roads in Luthrie are primary gritting roads for Fife Council.

- ii. De-silting the bridge to occur this year and thereafter annually (Fife Council).

4. Culvert Survey

A drone survey has taken place. The water spray from the drone obscured the camera. Fife Council are hoping to supply the name of someone who will walk the culvert.

5. Power Cut Resilience – Emergency space

a) Luthrie Village Hall Insurance will not cover gas fuelled heaters. An alternative location to be sought
