

## **Sub- group report to CC meeting on 7.8.2024**

The sub-group's next meeting is on 15.8.2024. Final minutes will be circulated to the CC.

The Scottish Government's Flooding Resilience Consultation document was circulated to the CC Committee for information along with this report. This Consultation document has been circulated to the Resilience Group with the following note:

*Please note: The Community Council has not given permission for the sub-group to respond directly to any Government body consultations. As individuals we may of course respond.*

A replacement for Fife Council's Lead Consultant, Flooding, Shoreline and Harbours is still being sought.

Resilience measures:

1. Fife Council's current position:

- a) The garden restoration and de-silting under the bridge is confirmed as scheduled for action this year.
- b) A second culvert survey is not planned
- c) The bridge has the capacity to cope with the water through the culvert

2. Household: 3 have tanked their cellars and installed flood doors or equivalent

3. Landowners: Offlets are planned for the hard-core road opposite the church and the creation of a pond is to be explored/ this autumn amenity woodland planting is planned by Mountquhanie.
