Notes on 22/5/2025 Meeting

### **1. House and Landowners Flood Measures**

- a) Back up generators to pumps to be installed by householders.
- b) Correction : Patrick Wedderburn has planted hedging and occasional trees along the field border above Brunton.
- c) Fife Council's recommendation of Leaky dams: further information on their implementation and impact locally to be sought.
- d) the upper reaches of the Windygates Burn to be walked.
- e) Ecosystem diversity : infill hedge planting along the Brunton to Luthrie road is planned for late 2025/ early 2026 led by a local independent volunteer group. The aim is to enhance water infiltration into the soil ; contribute to climate change mitigation e.g. store carbon and support biodiversity with the consolidation of a wildlife corridor.
